

**STATEMENT OF THE BOARDS OF THE TOWN OF BLOOMFIELD AND
VILLAGE OF BLOOMFIELD AS TO PROPOSED BOUNDARY
AGREEMENT**

The Town Board of Bloomfield and the Village Board of Bloomfield are considering a boundary agreement which would result in the transfer of the entirety of the Town of Bloomfield to the Village of Bloomfield. The boundary agreement would reunite all of historic Bloomfield under the municipal governance of the Village of Bloomfield ending a process first contemplated decades ago and significantly advanced by the incorporation of the current Village in 2011.

The boundary agreement under consideration would end the duplication of governmental bodies, protect the existing Town from annexations by the Village of Genoa City and the City of Lake Geneva, and reserve land use decisions to the local citizenry.

On April 7, 2020, the Town will hold an advisory referendum on such a boundary agreement. If the advisory referendum is approved, the Town and Village Boards will seek to forge a boundary agreement to accomplish the goal of reunifying historic Bloomfield as one Village.
